PETS IN THE PARK

POLICY

The Committee of Management (CoM) consider this club to be pet friendly. The following policy is to ensure the safe enjoyment of all members, guests and their pets.

- Casual Campers are restricted to one dog per site unless the express consent of the park Caretaker is first obtained. The Management has discretion on which dogs to allow into the park and to require the immediate removal of any pet deemed dangerous.
- Dogs must be restrained on a lead at all times within the Club area or securely contained within the site. This rule will be enforced by the Caretaker who reserves the right to remove any casual camper not complying or to request the removal of any unrestrained pet by the Mount Alexander Shire Ranger.
- The CoM reserves the right to ban or remove any pet that in the opinion of the CoM acts in a dangerous manner or becomes a threat to the safe enjoyment of Members or their pets.
- Members must not leave a dog or animal unattended or without arranging for someone to monitor the animal's behaviour and well-being.
- Pet owners must pick up and dispose of any faecal waste promptly and appropriately.
- Pet owners must not allow a pet to be a nuisance or cause distress to other Club users.
- Pets are not allowed in any building or amenities block.
- Pet owners agree to take full responsibility of any personal injury or damage caused by the pet while within the confines of the park and agree to pay for any claims of compensation in relation to the pet's activities.
