### UPGRADES UPDATE

**With our Fire Upgrade now successfully completed the committee is turning its attention to our next big project—our sewerage upgrade.**

The club recently submitted a proposal for the upgrade to Goulburn Murray Water and is pleased to report that the project proposal has been accepted.

Work is set to begin shortly on the upgrade of the toilet block nearest the Caretaker's Residence.

This will be followed by the upgrade of the central toilet block and later infrastructure works.

Works will be undertaken by member and plumber David Anderson and his team.

Care will be taken to minimise closure of the toilets/ showers where possible with projects to be carried out in quiet periods where timeframes allow.

## READY FOR THE RUSH

Earlier this year we asked members for feedback regarding a proposed annual maintenance levy. The majority of members voiced their support for the idea.

As previously outlined Mark is employed as our caretaker (not as a manager under the former park structure) and therefore is paid at a significantly reduced rate to enable us to save important funds towards our required upgrades.

Whilst Mark maintains the toilets, mows etc the maintenance levy allows us to get a handyman in on a regular basis to undertake the cleaning of gutters, whipper snipping, blowing etc reducing the need for regular working bees and ensuring we are ready for peak periods.
